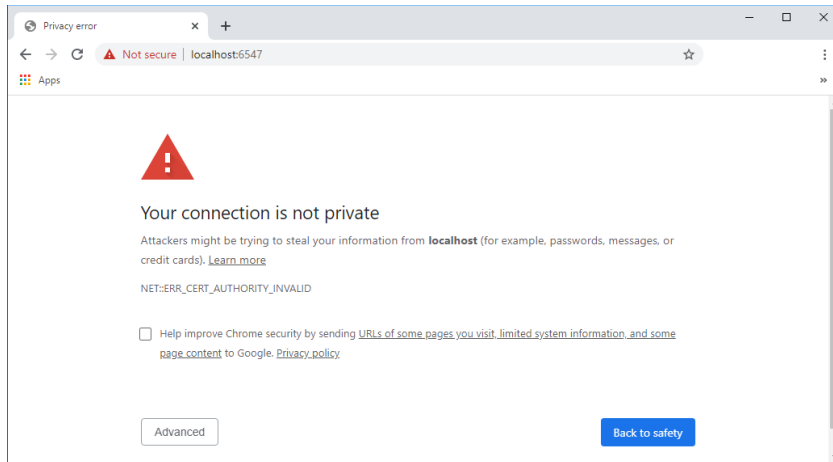


Installing PowerChute Business Edition Agent Security Certificate for Chrome:

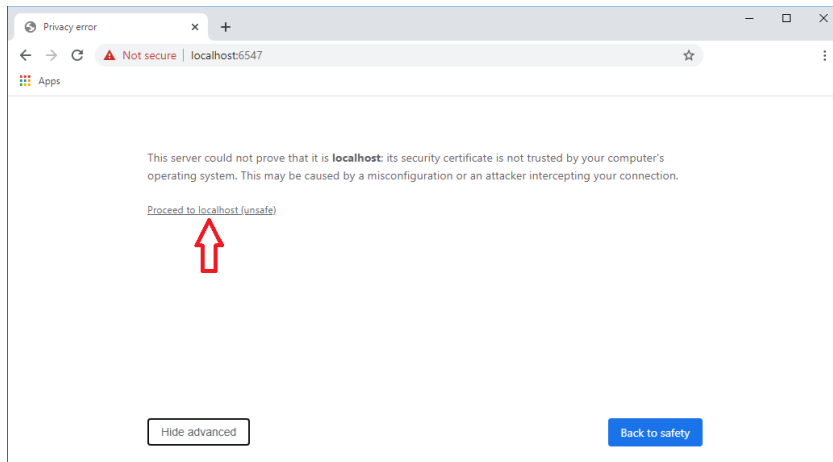
The PowerChute Business Edition Agent has a "self-signed" security certificate. This means that when you access your Agent installation, your browser will display warnings about the validity and security of the Agent site.

You will need to allow the certificate to proceed to the login page in Chrome.

1. After installing the PowerChute Agent, launch it. Chrome displays the following warning:

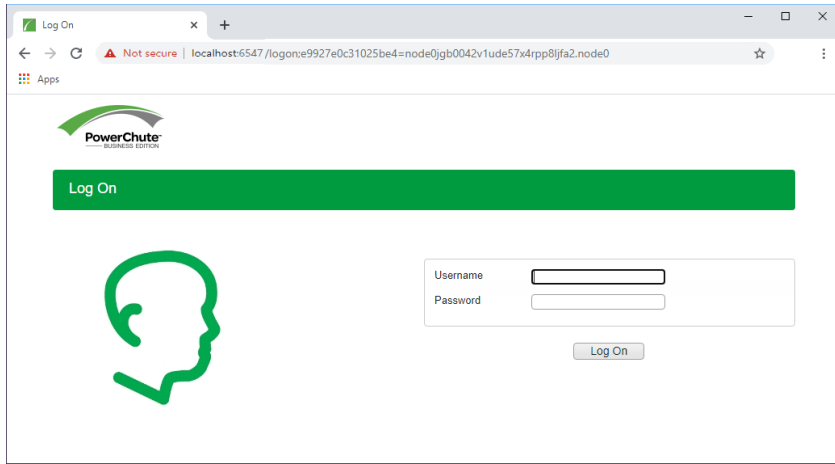


2. Click on **Advanced** to see this:



Click **Proceed to localhost**:

3. Once the risk has been accepted the Agent login page will launch.



NOTE: Currently, Chrome does not have a way of installing a certificate from a URL. But as Chrome relies on the Windows certificate store. The method described in [FAQ FA246199](#) to install an Agent security certificate for Internet Explorer works for Chrome also.

Launch IE browser and follow the step in [FAQ FA264199](#). Then restart Chrome and it will recognize the security certificate as being installed. The warning for PowerChute Agent will not display again.
