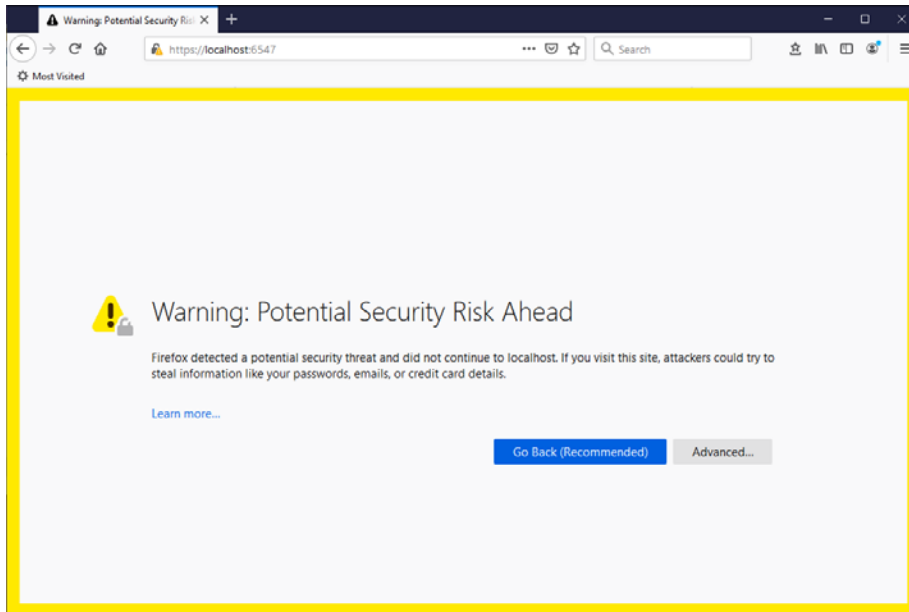


Installing PowerChute Business Edition Agent Security Certificate for Firefox:

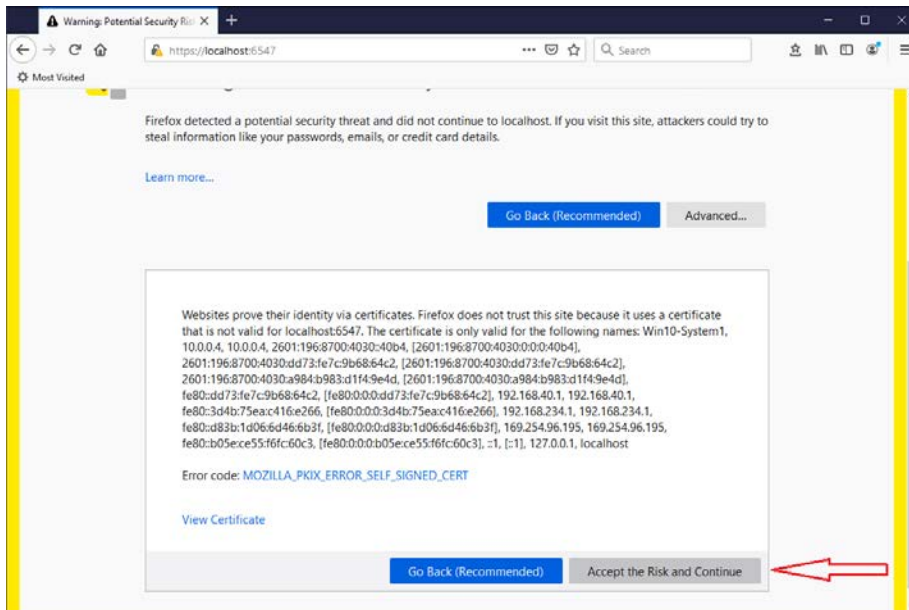
The PowerChute Business Edition Agent has a "self-signed" security certificate. This means that when you access your Agent installation, your browser will display warnings about the validity and security of the Agent site.

You will need to add the certificate to Firefox to proceed.

1. After installing the PowerChute Agent, launch it. Firefox displays the following warning:

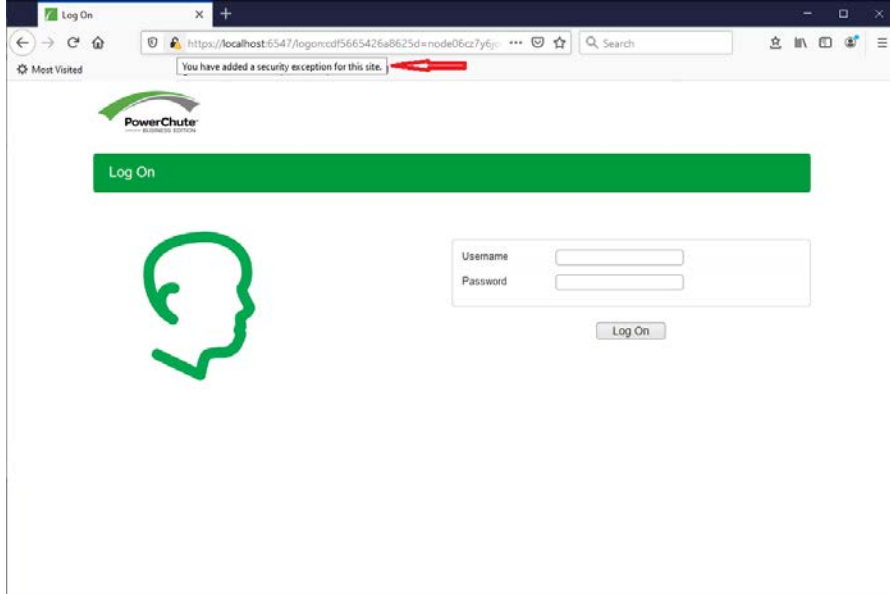


2. Click on **Advanced** to see this:



Click **Accept the Risk and Continue**:

- Once the risk has been accepted the security certificate will be added to Firefox. When the Agent login page launches if you hover the mouse over the lock icon in the address bar you will see that the certificate has been added.



NOTE: Currently, Firefox does not have a way of installing a certificate from a URL. But as Firefox relies on the Windows certificate store. The method described in [FAQ FA246199](#) to install an Agent security certificate for Internet Explorer works for Firefox also.

Launch IE browser and follow the step in [FAQ FA264199](#). Then restart Firefox and it will recognize the security certificate as being installed. The warning for PowerChute Agent will not display again.
